### YOUTH MODULE CERTIFICATE & YOUTH SOCCER ACADEMY - SPRING, 2010

Curriculum Emphasis of the Youth Module:

- Content of youth modules is same as the US Youth Soccer National Youth License and is age specific.
- The Youth Module focuses on the U6 - U8 and the U10 - U12 age groups.
- Focus of youth modules is the parent coach that has little or no experience in the game of soccer. The course offers "hands on" activities as well as covering characteristics of children, philosophy, organizing a lesson plan, care and prevention, and risk management.
- There is no testing.
